



HISTORY OF THE CONGREGATION

In the middle of the 19th century, Pondicherry mission was an important place for the French M.E.P. missionaries. The situation prevailing then in India was not pleasant. Women were considered as slaves and as second class citizens. Education to the girls was viewed as a curse to the family as well as to the country. The Missionaries were convinced that promoting the education of women was the only way to nurture the dignity of women and to raise the standard of the families.

At this juncture, a synod of priests was held in 1844 for which Fr. Louis savinien Dupuis drafted the programme. The president along with the Priests spoke emphatically about women education and proposed that a Congregation of indigenous sisters should be started with the responsibility of imparting education to women. This noble and tremendous task was entrusted in the hands of Rev. Fr. Louis savinien Dupuis who willingly accepted to launch in the vast ocean.

As women education was not thought of in India, Fr. Dupuis had to face innumerable oppositions. Being a man of deep faith in the Divine Providence, a man of understanding, and a man of vision, he faced those oppositions courageously and creatively. After strenuous efforts he started the Congregation of the Immaculate Heart of Mary of Pondicherry on the 16th of October 1844.

HISTORY OF THE SCHOOL

The seed for this gigantic centennial Institution was sown by the Pondicherry synod in 1844 which made the historic position to start a religious congregation for promoting women education . Accordingly the immaculate Heart of Mary Congregation was founded on 16th October 1844 and the very next day the Congregation started the Immaculate Heart of Mary School for Girls by Rev. Fr. Louis Savenien Dupuis, MEP

Speaking about the first days of the opening of the school Rev Fr. Dupuis, the founder of the Congregation and the school narrates, " For several weeks no girls turned up ; then 2 or 3 came and their examples brought in others, so much so, after a few months, the attendance was fairly good". At the initial stage both Tamil and French languages were the medium of instruction. In 1887 the then French Government recognized the school and granted substantial subsidy.

The land in which the present school is situated was donated by the MEP. The School functioned as Middle school till 1956. Then it was upgraded into High School. The medium of instruction was changed to English and the Matriculation system into S.S.L.C. system. In 1978, the 10+2 System was introduced.

The School had witnessed dedicated services of a host of eminent principals and teachers. Thousands of girl students have been moulded a trained in all aspects like physical, mental, intellectual and ethical. Immaculate students are stuning in every field.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Dear Parents, Guardians and Students

You are requested to co-operate with the school in the observance of all the rules and regulations laid down below and those announced by the school authorities as and when it is required.

A) To the students

1. Each student must have a diary which should be brought to the School daily. It is the means of communication for the school authorities and teachers with the parents about the child.
2. Every student shall respectfully wish the teachers irrespective of the classes they handle. Stand up and wish a teacher or a visitor when she enters or leaves the classroom. Maintain silence in the absence of a teacher. Behave well even outside the school in such a way that your teachers and parents may be proud of you.
3. During the class hours, order and silence need to be maintained. Running about, playing or shouting inside the school campus is strictly prohibited.
4. Come to school always on time neither too early nor late. No student is allowed to remain in the school premises after class hours
5. The school premises and your classroom should always be kept neat and clean, Since cleanliness is next to Godliness, every student shall consider cleanliness of dress and person as an essential virtue.
6. Any kind of damage to the school properties must be immediately reported to the Principal and made good by the respective student who caused it.
7. Every one should attend the morning assembly. Their movement from class to assembly and back, should be in an orderly manner. They should move silently but smartly in single line under the guidance of the class teacher or class leader.
8. Pupils from one class are not allowed to be in other class room during intervals. When pupils move along the corridor to another class or while going up and coming down the stair-case, the rule is Keep Left.
9. Prayers must be recited with respect and devotion. Pupils should not move about at the time of prayer and should be in attention while singing the National Anthem.
10. Mobile phones, jewels, electronic devices etc. are not allowed in the school.

11. The school is not responsible for the loss of books, money, clothes and other valuable articles.
12. Every student is expected to speak in English in the school Premises.
13. Scribbling on the bench/desk/wall/ doors and windows are strictly prohibited. Spitting and washing through the window is forbidden.
14. No gift or donations to be given to the teachers and friends.
16. Fighting and using abusive languages are strictly prohibited
17. Habitual absence and irregularity in home work are recorded and action will be taken.
18. Disobedience in any manner will be punishable
19. Children should not involve in robbery, cheating and forging signature
20. Loitering around in and outside the school campus during and after the class hours is prohibited.

21. Kindly follow the uniform rules:-

- a. Fancy and gold ornaments are not permitted
- b. Different hair styles and any kind of make up are not allowed
- c. Parents should see that your ward is wearing washed and ironed uniform

NB: All these rules should strictly be followed. If not, strict disciplinary action will be taken.

B) To the Parents

1. Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities by confirming regularity and discipline, helping their children to prepare lessons and taking a keen interest in the activities of the school.
2. Parents those who require various certificates like conduct certificate, fees certificate of your ward, need to submit a request in writing to the office, at least two days in advance.
3. Parents or other persons are not allowed to see students or meet their teachers during class hours without the permission of the Principal.
4. The school hand book is a record and means of communication with the parents. Parents have to check their ward's hand book daily.
5. Sick students should not be sent to school.

6. Criticising the teachers in front of your ward should be avoided, because it may make them lose respect for their teachers.
7. Students who disobey, carry out an illegal or anti social activities or break the rules and code of conduct of the school are liable to have their names struck off from the school register.
8. Borrowing or lending of money as well as exchanging article is prohibited. The School is not responsible for any issue.
9. Bringing smart watches, mobile phones, expensive items to school is strictly forbidden, Such items will be confiscated.
